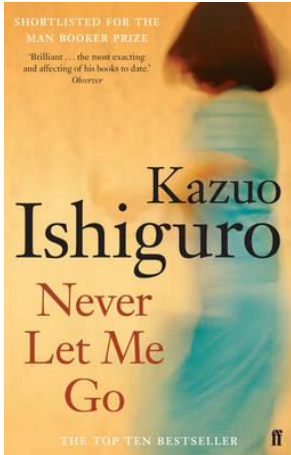


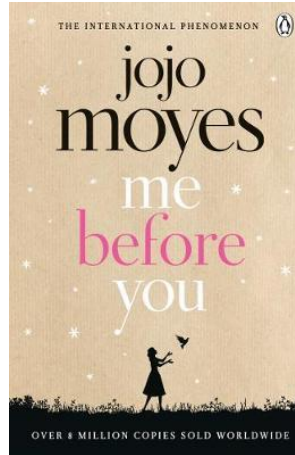

In the spirit of the Oscars, here are some of our favourite books that have been made into movies, from sci-fi to thrillers, and weepy dramas to clever true stories.

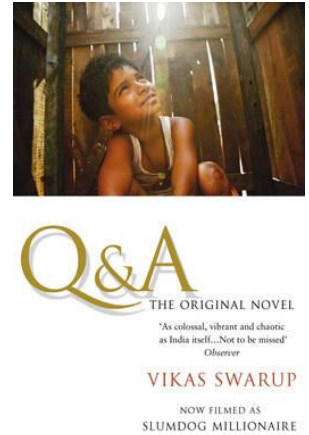
