


Space

Go on a galactic adventure with the last human on earth, Earth, his alien best friend, and a depressed android.




[The Sky at Night: Book of the Moon](#) by Maggie Aderin-Pocock

Lunar expert and space scientist Dr Maggie Aderin-Pocock takes readers on a journey through the Moon's past, present and future.




[Guardians of the Galaxy: Cosmic Avengers](#) by Brian Michael Bendis and Steve McNiven

Why has Earth become the most important planet in the galaxy? That's what the Guardians of the Galaxy are going to find out!




[The Book of Strange New Things](#) by Michael Faber

[The Loneliest Girl in the Universe](#) by Lauren James


Alone in space, Romy Silvers is the loneliest girl in the universe until she hears about a new ship which has launched from Earth - with a single passenger on board.



[The Left Hand of Darkness](#) by Ursula K. Le Guin


Genly Ai, visitor to the planet Gethen, finds love on a journey through a frozen winter landscape.



These seven short lessons guide us, with simplicity and clarity, through the scientific revolution that shook physics in the twentieth century.




[I Am a Dalek](#) by Gareth Roberts
