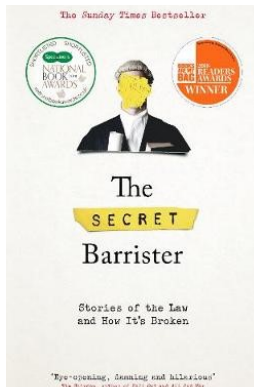


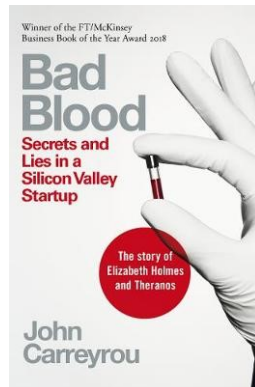

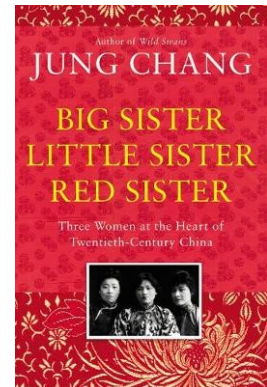

Stories from the daily life of a barrister to show how the system is broken, who broke it and why we should start caring before it's too late.



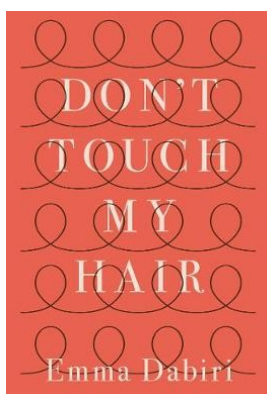

The full inside story of the breathtaking rise and shocking collapse of Theranos, the multibillion-dollar biotech startup.



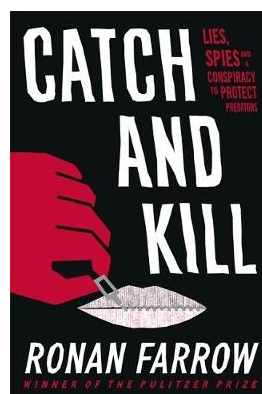

A group biography that reveals the lives of three extraordinary women who helped shape twentieth-century China.



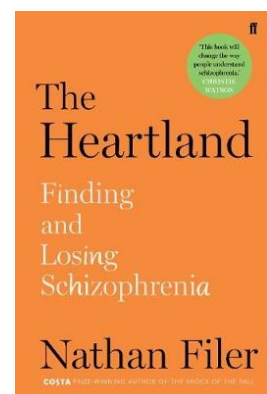

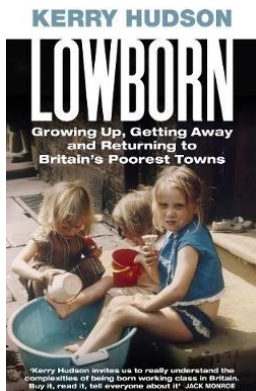

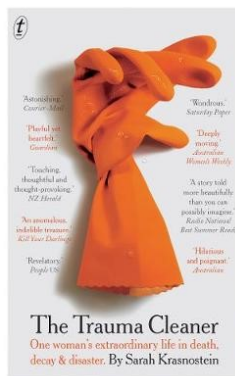
A journey into psychiatric wards as experts and extraordinary people share their own stories of living with schizophrenia.

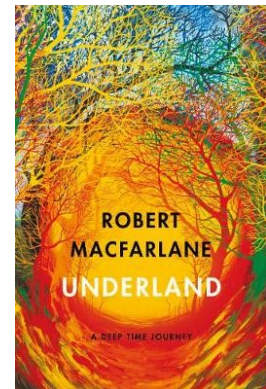
[Lowborn](#) by Kerry Hudson

Revisiting the towns she grew up in, Kerry Hudson discovers what being poor really means in Britain today and whether anything has changed.



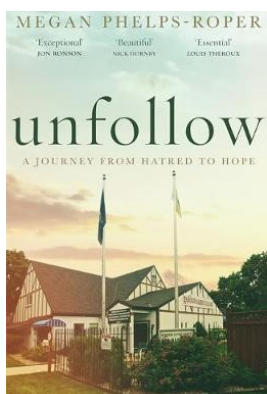
[The Trauma Cleaner](#) by Sarah Krasnostein

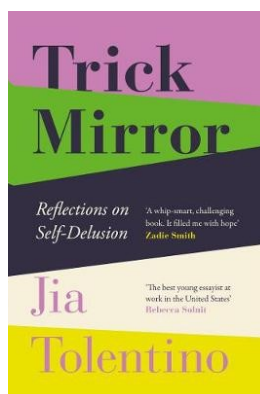

A journey into the worlds beneath our feet, a deep-time voyage into the planet's past and future.



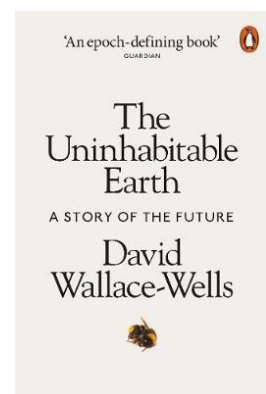
