




## Radio 2 Book Club recommendations April to June 2021

Every month there is a featured book and author interview, as well as another recommended read from the panel.


The books below were chosen, in part, by librarians from across the UK, from hundreds of submissions.


*Project Hail Mary* by Andy Weir


*How to Kidnap the Rich* by Rahul Raina


*Hostage* by Clare Mackintosh
