Appalled by what he sees, Santa writes a letter to his animal friends asking them to clear up. And over the course of twelve fun-filled days, they work together to do just that! A fun-filled eco picture book based on the classic festive rhyme and the perfect introduction to recycling and reusing for a new generation.

Jelly isn't feeling the festive spirit – or excitement about the mermicorn – quite as much until he receives a mysterious



present... But who is it from? A wonderfully silly early graphic-novel series featuring a fun ocean fact page and joke page.

Agnes and Attie are bound for the Antarctic on their second creature-crazy wildlife-rescue adventure. What is causing the tremors threatening to destroy the rescue centre? Why are the local Adelie penguins behaving so bizarrely?

Children will be inspired to discover the world with these character-driven adventure stories for children aged 7 to 9 years old. Learn all about polar expeditions and the Arctic in this climate-related installment of DK Books' new educational fiction series for children. In this fun, fact-filled children's book, engineering expert Kiki and Connor the marine biologist are sent on a mission to the Arctic. There they discover a research vessel studying the effects of climate change that has become trapped in the sea ice.

In the forest near Mangoshi's village in Africa there grows a very special flower. Mangoshi knows that only this flower can save her mother's life. It can save her village too. All she has to do is find it. Ben Okri and Diana Ejaita have created a magical world of beauty and colour, an enchanting array of extraordinary trees, each with its own personality and voice. An environmental fairytale made for our times, written to be read by adults and children.

A positive journal-style, pocket-sized activity book full of mindful activities to help children feel festive, perfect their crafting skills and learn about holidays from around the world. Activities include



celebrating the winter solstice, following a full Moon cycle, making unique decorations and even tips for the perfect, warming hot chocolate. Comes with a back cover pocket for storing treasured memories.

A Mouse Called Miika by Matt Haig, ill. Chris Mould (Canongate) ISBN: 978-1838853686

One independent mouse sets out on a quest of his own to prove that cheese exists, and learns to appreciate other creatures. It is also a tale of great love (of cheese) and great danger. And learning the lesson that, with cheese, as with life, what matters most is not how strongly you smell, but how strong you are on the inside. Funny, cheeky, wise, and packed full of Matt Haig's signature warmth. This is set to become a year-round children's favourite.

They come together unexpectedly on a cold English beach with the arrival of a rare and wondrous sea creature: a giant leatherback turtle. This is a terrific positive-action mystery and first in a series of hilarious, poignant and highly original stories on environmental matters.

When orphan Matthew Henson ran away from his violent stepmother to find a new life in the big city, no one could have predicted that he would become the first man to reach the North Pole. A little luck and a lot of hard work led to a life of adventure on the high seas and in the Arctic, but back home in America his achievements were ignored due to the colour of his skin. Race to the Frozen North tells his remarkable true story. This book has a dyslexia-friendly layout, typeface and paper-stock so that more readers can enjoy it.

This debut children's novel takes a sleigh ride into the heart of a magical adventure. A young boy called Ash and his disagreeable yeti guardian find themselves on an explorers' expedition, where his special powers could come in very handy. Can the daring explorers help Ash find his family?

The Girl Who Speaks Bear by Sophie Anderson, ill. Kathrin Honesta (Usborne) ISBN: 978-1474940672

Found abandoned in a bear cave as a baby, Yanka has always wondered about where she is from. She tries to ignore the strange whispers and looks from the villagers, wishing she was as strong on the inside as she is on the outside. But, when she has to flee her house, a journey far beyond one that she ever imagined begins: from icy rivers to mountains, meeting extraordinary friends along the way.
