






# HELP AUTUMN AND EDITH FIND THEIR HATS

# SPOOKY BAT BISCUITS

### Ingredients

200g unsalted butter, softened
200g golden caster sugar
1 large egg
½ tsp vanilla extract (optional)
400g plain flour, plus extra for dusting
Icing sugar or caster sugar for decoration (optional)
Bat-shaped biscuit cutter



### Method

- 1. Get an adult's help with this Heat the oven to 200C/180C fan/gas mark 6;
- 2. Line an oven tray with baking parchment.
- 3. Put the butter in a bowl and beat it with electric beaters, or a fork, until soft and creamy.
- 4. Mix in the sugar, egg, and vanilla, and mix together.
- 5. Add the flour to make a dough. If the dough feels a bit sticky, add a little bit more flour and knead it in.
- 6. Roll out the dough to the thickness of about 1cm on a floured surface.
- 7. Cut out shapes using a bat biscuit cutter.
- 8. Transfer the individual biscuits to the baking sheet and bake for 8-10 mins or until the edges are just brown.
- 9. Leave to cool for about 5 mins.
- 10. As an extra, you can sprinkle with caster sugar or use icing sugar to decorate.






# PUPPET THEATRE

- 2. Cut the other piece of card into two right-angled triangles
- 3. Fold each triangle to make a flap
- 4. Stick the flap to the back of the scene card so it can stand on its own
- 5. Colour in your Autumn Moonbeam characters
- 6. Cut them out using the dotted lines
- 7. Stick each character to a lolly stick, leaving stick at top or bottom to hold it.

# You'll need: - Scissors (ask a grown-up first!) - Colouring pens or pencils - Glue or cellotape - Two flat pieces of card - Lolly sticks
